- River Champion digital material to help you promote your project.
- Support with signage wording for your community-led projects.
- A chance to feedback, telling us what you think of the scheme to help us guide our future work.
- Support creating a constituted group or 'Friends of' group if appropriate.
- Signposting relevant funding that your community group can apply for.
- Your point of contact will be the Wilder Communities Manager within the Trust.

What we expect from you:

- You'll talk about the work you're doing and tell people about our campaign for a Wilder Essex.
 This could be on social media, word of mouth, in your local paper or newsletters.
- You'll support and share learning with other River Champions.
- You'll share your experiences with us so we can share them with our funders, supporters and other communities.
- The role of a River Champion is a representative and not an employee or volunteer of the Trust. Any references of the Trust that your work makes will not bring the Trust into disrepute.

What not to expect:

- You remain responsible for your projects, activities and events at all times. The Wildlife Trust cannot accept responsibility for them or provide you with insurance. We can provide guidance on how to access the right insurance, and the health and safety requirements you need to consider.
- We cannot reimburse you for any travel, equipment or any other expenditure that may occur during your time as an River Champion.
