We are looking for a Centre Assistant to join us on a fixed term contract until end of March 2026 at our idyllic Nature Discovery Centre in the ancient Belfairs woodland in Leigh-on-Sea.

The Role

Belfairs Woodland Centre introduces visitors to the 1160-acre local landscape, a third of which is woodland, including a number of outstanding sites valuable for nature conservation. It is a crucial green lung surrounded by urban areas and provides a tremendous green space of great importance to local people of the Boroughs of Southend and Castle Point.

Much of the woodland is officially 'ancient woodland'; some is more than 1,000 years old, making it the earliest woodland recorded in Essex. The woodlands are home to a number of historic landscape features and a wide variety of flora and fauna, including several nationally threatened species such as the Hazel dormouse, the Song thrush and the Heath fritillary butterfly.

The Nature Discovery Centre offers an opportunity to discover the wildlife within the park whilst enjoying refreshments and a gift shop, run by a friendly team and wonderful volunteers who are passionate about providing fantastic customer service.





As a Centre Assistant, the role will include serving customers in both retail and food and beverage areas, operating tills, and preparing drinks using the barista machine. Responsibilities also include maintaining a clean and organised environment and restocking shelves. You will work closely with our dedicated volunteers, who are passionate about supporting the Trust's mission. All revenue generated from our visitor centres directly funds vital conservation work across our reserves in Essex.

Working as part of a visitor centre team, the post holder will need to be a team player who can engage in a welcoming and professional way with our visitors - ensuring excellent customer service is always at the forefront.

We are looking for a friendly individual with an interest in customer service to join Essex Wildlife Trust in this visitor engagement role.



Job Description

- Greet and engage visitors at all stages of their experience.
- Prepare and serve hot and cold food and beverage refreshments.
- Keep front-of-house areas clean, tidy, and inviting to enhance the visitor experience.
- Collaborate with the team to meet centre targets and ensure smooth daily operations.
- Promote retail, food, and membership opportunities to boost revenue and donations.
- Maintain high standards of hygiene and follow all health, safety, and security policies.
- Address visitor inquiries and feedback professionally, escalating issues when needed.
- Follow procedures for stock control, deliveries, EPOS, and food & beverage services.
- Engage visitors to promote the centre and the work of Essex Wildlife Trust.
- Communicate effectively with staff and volunteers, attending team meetings as needed.
- To undertake any other duties which are commensurate with the role

Additional Information

- This role is 22.5 hours per week.
- The Nature Discovery Centre is open every day of the year, with the exception for Christmas Day and Boxing Day.
- Hours available will usually be between the hours of 9am and 5pm, Monday to Sunday, all-year round. The role will involve weekend working.

Terms

The position is a fixed term role until 29 March 2026, working 22.5 hours per week between Monday and Sunday on a rota basis to include weekend and bank holiday working. The starting salary is £14,285.70 per annum (FTE £23,809.50).
