The Role

Ingrebourne Nature Discovery Centre provides much-needed community facilities and education opportunities to Hornchurch Country Park; a well used and much loved open space, of great importance to people and wildlife.

The centre offers a shop, café, toilets, education/community room, displays and a wide range of events to engage the whole community, run by a friendly team and wonderful volunteers who are passionate about providing fantastic customer service.

Also to be admired is the fascinating wildlife and heritage of the park and the surrounding Ingrebourne Valley landscape.





As a Centre Assistant, the role will include serving customers in both retail and food and beverage areas, operating tills, preparing drinks using the barista machine, cooking and assisting in events.

Responsibilities also include maintaining a clean and organised environment and restocking shelves. You will work closely with our dedicated staff and volunteers, who are passionate about supporting the Trust's mission. All surplus revenue generated from our visitor centres directly funds vital conservation work across our reserves in Essex.

Working as part of a visitor centre team, the post holder will need to be a team player who can engage in a welcoming and professional way with our visitors - ensuring excellent customer service is always at the forefront.

We are looking for a friendly individual with an interest in customer service to join Essex Wildlife Trust in this visitor engagement role.



Job Description

- Greet and engage visitors at all stages of their experience.
- Prepare and serve hot and cold food and beverage refreshments.
- Keep front-of-house areas clean, tidy, and inviting to enhance the visitor experience.
- Collaborate with the team to meet centre targets and ensure smooth daily operations.
- Promote retail, food, and membership opportunities to boost revenue and donations.
- Maintain high standards of hygiene and follow all health, safety, and security policies.
- Address visitor inquiries and feedback professionally, escalating issues when needed.
- Follow procedures for stock control, deliveries, EPOS, and food & beverage services.
- Engage visitors to promote the centre and the work of Essex Wildlife Trust.
- Communicate effectively with staff and volunteers, attending team meetings as needed.
- To undertake any other duties which are commensurate with the role.

Additional Information

- The Nature Discovery Centre is open every day of the year, with the exception for Christmas Day and Boxing Day.
- The role will entail weekend work and on the odd occasion some evenings.

The position is a permanent role, working 14 hours per week between Monday and Sunday on a rota basis to include weekend and bank holiday working. The rate of pay for this role is £13.08 per hour.
